

ATTACHMENT A - STATEMENT OF WORK

Midwest Heritage Language Network

Scope of Work for Sub Award to The University of Illinois at Chicago

Objective or purpose: To contribute to the formation of the Midwest Heritage Language Corpus through cleaning of a set of existing interviews and coding a subset of interviews.

Period of performance (work must be completed within the project budget period), March 1, 2015 -- September 1, 2016

Consultant responsibilities, tasks, and expected results:

- Provide cleaned transcriptions of 127 existing speech samples
- Collaborate in the coding of a small sample of these speech samples
- All work developed as part of the terms of this Sub-Award Agreement shall be made available for use by the Midwest Heritage Language Network Project

Performance, quality and timeliness requirements (Include required or acceptable levels of performance on each specified task measured in terms of accuracy, response time, and speed):

- Sub-awardee must provide cleaned transcription of all 127 speech samples within the specified timeline
- Sub-awardee will attend 80% of all study team meetings unless absences are excused.

Workload requirements (describe levels or size of contractual effort):

- UIC will hire one or more Graduate Research Assistants
- Graduate Research Assistants will be hired for 390 hours of work spread over the course of the project period
- Graduate Research Assistants will be compensated at a rate of \$21 per hour with a fringe benefit rate of 10%.

Reporting requirements and/or other deliverables:

UIC will deliver 127 cleaned transcriptions by the end of the performance period

UIC will provide a subset of cleaned transcriptions for coding
